A literary contest for Papua New Guinean writers

THE CROCODILE PRIZE was established in 2010 to provide an opportunity for Papua New Guinean writers to publish their work. The contest is open only to citizens of Papua New Guinea.

It has six categories:

- short story • poetry • heritage • essay • student • lifetime achievement.
- There is also a special award for women's literature covering all categories.

SHORT STORIES

Not more than 1,500 words on a theme of interest to a general readership

POETRY

Not more than 300 words on a theme of interest to a general readership

ESSAYS

Not more than 1,500 words on a factual theme of interest to a general readership

HERITAGE

Not more than 1,500 words on a cultural theme

STUDENT

Not more than 1,500 words on any theme by School or High School students.

PRIZE

There will be a prize of K5,000 and a trophy awarded to the writer of the winning entry in each category.

ENTRIES

You may submit more than one entry into any of the categories.

DEADLINE

Entries must be submitted by Friday 31 May 2013. The winners will be announced at the awards ceremony Thursday 12 September 2013.

PUBLICATION

The best entries will be published in The Crocodile Prize Anthology 2012. *This year's anthology will be G-Rated to ensure suitability for distribution to schools.*
